Multiple ambulance rides to the Johnson City Children's Hospital, even one by helicopter. Tests, tests and more tests to determine the best course of action. Medicine and more medicine to trial and error until we find that perfect combination. After multiple hospital stays in the hospital, through the monitors we will always get the precious toothy grin from Gentry.
He is such a social butterfly and has such a love for people. When he smiles he makes the world around him alright again, especially for us - even if a fleeting moment. Gentry knows that he is loved.
